#### I. Approval of Minutes

## II. Uniform Act on Prevention of and Remedies for Human Trafficking (National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws 2013)

The Council reviewed the Act for recommendations, and found that overall Connecticut's law is stronger than the Uniform Act. The Council made the following suggestions:

- Article 1: Definitions –request that the Office of Legislative Research compare the Uniform Act definitions to CT definitions
  - O Suggestion to change the National Model as follows (underline added language):
    - "A person commits the crime of trafficking in persons when he or she compels or induces another person, through coercion, <u>fraud</u>, or threatened use of force against the person <u>or a third person</u>."
- Article IV, Section 20 Public Awareness Committee will amend and submit as a recommendation
